

Space Requirements

- A. Check your existing space dimensions, including height and width. Most new dishwashers require 34" H x 24" W to be able to fit.
- B. Look at the flooring in front to confirm the existing unit can be removed. Sometimes, if you've had flooring replaced after the dishwasher was installed, the new flooring prevents us from getting the old unit out of the space.

Water and Drain Supply

- A. Make sure the water supply shut off valve operates to turn off the water supply. Sometimes they freeze in place and won't operate properly, requiring replacement.
- B. Determine the location of where the drain line connects to your home plumbing. It should be under your sink, next to the dishwasher.

Countertop

- A. Confirm the type of countertop you have so we can know what we will need to do to secure the dishwasher in place.
